

Part 1 - Draft Fund Set-Up

The BMDCC will set up a Draft Fund account with monies being transferred from the General Account. An immediate initial deposit of \$4000 will start the Draft Fund for the 2013 calendar year. The BMDCC will continue to support draft efforts by annually transferring an amount of \$2500 into the Draft Fund commencing January 2014.

Part 2 - Sponsorship Program

The BMDCC is committed to supporting our breed's working heritage. As a part of that commitment, the BMDCC will offer a Draft Test Sponsorship up to \$1000, to any club member committed to hosting a draft test.

The BMDCC Draft Test Sponsorship Program is available to any BMDCC club member in good standing who wishes to host a Sanctioned Draft Test. The test must be approved by the BMDCC executive committee.

The Draft Test host will provide the BMDCC executive a written proposal of intent to hold a draft test. The proposal must include a budget, which will include estimated entry income, fundraising income, ad income and all anticipated expenses including all judges expenses, venue rental, catalogue printing and CKC fees. Items such as lunches, special prizes, welcome gifts, decorations, arm bands, and an miscellaneous expenses should also be included.

After approval of the draft test proposal, the BMDCC will sponsor an amount not to exceed \$1000. The exact amount allocated will be based on the proposed budget and will be determined on a case by case basis.

The BMDCC to provide qualifying rosettes.

On conclusion of the Draft Test, the final accounting will be submitted to the club with any profit made going back into the BMDCC Draft Fund.
